Jude 24-25

Might we focus our attention on God's actions and attributes and celebrate these.

I. THE ADDRESSEES (25a)

A. THE ONLY GOD OUR SAVIOR

- 1. His Uniqueness Deut. 6:4
- 2. His Title: Savior See I Tim. 1:1; 2:3; 4:10

B. THROUGH JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD

- 1. God and Christ's partnership
- a. They work together for our good ... to protect and present us (v.24)
- b. The work of God and Christ are often coupled
 - See Rom. 16:27; Gal. 1:3-5; Eph. 3:20-21 and I Tim. 1:12-17 and 2:5
- 2. We come to God through Christ
 - See John 14:6; Col. 1:19-20 and I Tim. 2:5
- 3. Apostates seek to destroy God's grace in Christ Note v. 4

II. CHRIST'S ABILITIES (24)

A. HE PROTECTS US

- 1. He keeps or guards us so that we do not stumble
 - See Psalm 37:23-24 and 121:1-3
- 2. He keeps us from stumbling
- a. Stumbling is the first stage of a fall ... Christ doesn't even allow it to start!
- b. No stumbling into apostasy or grievous sin I Cor. 10:13
- c. We are not self-reliant!

B. HE PERFECTS US

- 1. Christ presents us blameless
 - Unscathed, without blame or blemish Is. 1:18; Eph. 5:25-27
- 2. Christ presents us guiltless
 - We stand before the Judge without guilt I John 2:1-2
- 3. Christ presents us joyous
- a. The joy: Cheering or extreme joy See Luke 1:44
- b. Our joy: I Peter 1:4-8
- c. His joy: Eph. 2:4-7

III. GOD'S ACCOLADES (25b)

- I, though alone, will do this ...

A. GIVE HIM GLORY

- 1. Showcasing the manifested excellence of God See Luke 2:9
- 2. Illus: Like an exquisite diamond

B. REMEMBER HIS MAJESTY

- 1. Underscoring God's splendor and magnificence. His dignity and integrity. Is. 6:1
- 2. Acknowledging His right to be admired

C. SUBMIT TO HIS DOMINION

- 1. Recognizing and submitting to His universal and powerful rule Ps. 103:19
- 2. Knowing that as sovereign King, He is in charge of everything

D. HONOR HIS AUTHORITY

- 1. Needing no certification to authenticate or validate His actions
- 2. The right of self-determination See Rom. 9:21
- 3. Exp: Note Christ's testimony about Himself in Matt. 28:18

E. PROVIDE CEASELESS PRAISE

- 1. Before the ages ... now ... and into eternity
- 2. From eternity to eternity
