BATTLING BITTERNESS

Hebrews 12:14-17

God's Word reveals the causes and cures for bitterness.

I. REASONS FOR BITTERNESS

- Some conditions that cause bitterness

A. MISTREATMENT

- 1. Esau's Issue Genesis 27:41-45
 - Jacob had stolen his blessing through deception
- 2. Joseph's bothered brothers Genesis 37: 1-20
 - a. They are not favored (v. 3-4)
 - b. They are not impressed (vs. 5-11)
 - c. They are not restrained (vs. 18-20)

B. DISCONTENTMENT

- 1. With people: Ahab's pouting I Kings 21:1-4
- 2. With God: Job's disgust Job 3 & 10
- a. God wouldn't let Job die Job. 3:20-26
- b. God wouldn't answer nor deliver Job Job. 10:1-2, 7
- c. God wouldn't leave Job alone Job 10:18-20

II. RESOLVING BITTERNESS

- Some cures for overcoming bitterness

A. WITH PEOPLE

- 1. Interact Matt. 5:43-44
- a. Personally: Love them (see also Lev. 19:18)
- b. Spiritually: Pray for them
- 2. Yield I Corinthians 9:3-12
 - Give up the rights you could exercise
- 3. Engage Hebrews 12:14-17
- a. Be aggressive (14)
 - About peace with men and purity with God
- b. Apply grace (15a)
 - Don't go without it
- c. Avoid problems (15b-17)
 - Because the buried blossoms and that bitterness contaminates

B. WITH GOD

- 1. Repent Job. 42:1-6
 - Because knowing who is better than knowing why
- 2. Worship Habakkuk 3:16-19
- a. Though desperate times come ... (16-17)
- b. We can rejoice and rely on God's provisions (18-19)

CONCLUSION:

We will battle bitterness when we behave according to God's Word
