 3. A prayer of comfort (19:30 with Luke 23:46)

- Some principles from Christ's practices

A. WE NEED WORSHIPFUL TEACHERS  
 - Are we willing to teach others God's truths?

B. WE NEED COMMITTED CHRISTIANS  
 - Do we commit to God's interests?

C. WE NEED TO CONNECT WITH CHRISTIAN BROTHERS AND SISTERS  
 - Are we thoughtful and purposeful about fellowship?

D. WE NEED PRAYERFUL PEOPLE  
 - Do we regularly communicate with the Father?
