# **FAITH: FOR SURE AND FOR CERTAIN**

## Hebrews 10:36-11:3

#### The foundation of a firm faith is essential for the Christian life

### I. **THE PRELUDE** (10:36-39)

#### A. REMEMBER GOD'S DESIRE FOR FAITH (36-38)

- 1. The Statement (38)
- 2. The Specifics (36-37)
  - a. Believe you will conquer (36)
- b. Believe Christ is coming (37)

#### B. RECALL A DECLARATION OF FAITH (39)

- 1. We are not the "falling away" ones
- 2. We are the faithfully persevering ones

### II. **THE PICTURE** (11:1-3)

#### A. FAITH DESCRIBED (1)

- It is more than redemptive ... it is productive
- 1. The assurance of things hoped for > How we think ... our confidence
- a. Reality: A certainty that what is promised will be performed
- b. Examples: Eve in Gen. 4:1; Shadrach and Co. in Dan. 3:16-18; Mary in Luke 1:26-38
- c. Applications
  - 1) What do we hope for, believing it will come?
- 2) Faith motivates and inspires us See I John 2:28-3:3
- 2. The conviction of things not seen > How we function ... our conduct
- a. Reality: Faith if the framework that holds up the things we cannot see
  - We act in obedience because we believe that God knows what He is doing even when we don't
- b. Examples: Noah in Gen. 6:13-22; Abraham in Gen. 12:1-2; Joshua in Josh. 6:1-6, 16-20
- c. Application
  - We commit to things that we cannot see Read II Cor. 4:16-18 and 5:7

#### B. FAITH DEMONSTRATED (2-3)

- 1. Formerly (2)
- a. People of faith gained approval from God and men
- b. Consider: Job in Job 1:20-21 then 42:12; Joseph in Gen. 39:1-4; Daniel in Dan. 6:3-5
- 2. Presently (3)
- a. We understand: Knowledge is not independent of faith
- b. We marvel: That the worlds were prepared by God's word
- c. We acknowledge: An unseen Maker created what we see
- d. We confess: A supernatural causation and not a natural one See Psalm 19:1

## **CONCLUSION**:

#### We can persevere and press on because we are a people of faith

- As such we are:
  - 1. Assured by God (v. 1)
  - 2. Approved by God (v. 2)
  - 3. In awe of God (v. 3)
