The Horrors of Hades

THE APPOINTMENT

Hebrews 9:27

We need to understand what God's Word says about man's appointment with death and judgment.

I. THE CERTAINTY OF HUMANITY - Hebrews 9:27

- The "All-Men" Appointments

A. AN APPOINTMENT

- Recorded on God's calendar ... He has your name in His appointment book

B. WITH DEATH

- 1. There is certainty to our mortality See Genesis 3:19 and Romans 5:12
- 2. Consider these realities
- a. Every year 55.3 million people in the world have an appointment with death recorded in God's book.
- b. 151,600 people die every day ... That's 6,316 per hour ... Or 107 per minute!
- 3. People die once: It is a singular event
- a. Literally: We die once for all
- b. There are no second chances, do-overs or mulligans
- 4. At death one's destiny is sealed

C. THEN JUDGMENT

- 1. Decision: God actively examines and evaluates at the moment of death
- 2. Determination: The "Then-what?" question is answered
- 3. Evaluation: God evaluates your standing with Him
- 4. Condemnation: The Greek word for "judgment" is "Crisis"
- a. After death a crisis comes to the unbelieving ... they are not justified and redeemed by Christ
- b. If the Savior does not pay on your account ... you will!
- c. The unbelieving faces the reality of this crisis when they realize they are not in Heaven

II. **THE REALITY OF WRATH** - Hebrews 10:26-31

- The "Evil-Man" appointment

A. FOR TRUTH DENIERS (26-27)

- 1. Their Rebellion (26)
 - Willingly continuing to sin even when the truth is known
- 2. God's Indignation (27)
 - a. Described here as a terrifying expectation
 - b. A fiery fury that eats away at God's enemies See II Thess. 1:7-9
 - c. God's love does not override His wrath! See Romans 1:18

B. FOR GRACE DESPISERS (28-29)

- 1. Example (28)
 - Old Testament Law-rejecters died without mercy
- 2. Comparison (29)
- a. How much worse for those who refuse God's grace!
- b. These are those who:
 - 1) Trample on the Son of God > Showing contempt for God the Father's provision
 - 2) Despise Christ's blood > Counting as ordinary (unclean) or profane the payment of God's Son
- 3) Insult the Spirit's grace > An arrogant outrage to the Spirit's plea
- c. See Romans 2:4-5

C. FOR GOD-REJECTORS (30-31)

- 1. The Words of God (30) [From Deut. 32:35-36]
- a. "I will repay"
 - It means to repay in kind ...i.e. with vengeance See Ezekiel 7:3-27
- b. "I will judge"
 - Examined and found to be enemies of God, who is therefore justified in allowing their damnation
- 2. The Warning to Men (31)
- a. This is a terrifying thing
 - Men will not be scared to death but rather scared of deity!
- b. This is a dreadful thing
 - 1) In the grip of the living God
 - 2) These unbelievers wanted to keep God at a distance ... but are now in His grip!

CONCLUSION:

Since I began my message 3,675 people have died

- All of these had an appointment with death and judgment and many are in Hades right now

For them it's too late to change their fate

- But what about you or your loved ones?
- There's still time for you to repent of sin and accept Christ as Savior
- See John 3:17-19

Where will you be meeting God at your appointment with death?

- In Heaven or Hades?
