ABRAHAM AND SARAH'S FAITH

Hebrews 11:8-12

Let's see how Abraham and Sarah's faith functioned as they traveled with God

I. ABRAHAM'S LEAVING (8)

A. HE OBEYED WHEN CALLED

- 1. The calling: An invitation to participate
- 2. The obedience: He answered the summons

B. HE WENT TO RECEIVE AN INHERITANCE

- 1. This could be exciting but also exasperating
- 2. Going out > He left all that was familiar

C. HE DIDN'T KNOW WHERE HE WAS GOING

- 1. His is a daring faith
- 2. He was totally unfamiliar with where he was going
- 3. Note: He did not know where he was going, but he did know who was calling him

II. **ABRAHAM'S LIVING** (9)

A. AS AN ALIEN

- 1. A visitor
- 2. In a foreign land

B. IN TENTS

- 1. Portable housing
- 2. Putting down no roots

C. WITH FAMILY

- 1. Living in nothing permanent
- 2. As heirs of God's promise

III. ABRAHAM'S LOOKING (10)

A. HE IS FUTURE-FOCUSED

- 1. Expecting something more
- 2. Not caught up in the temporal

B. HE IS CITY-FOCUSED

- 1. A city with foundations
- 2. A city implies fellowship See Heb. 12:22-24
- 3. A city designed and built by God

IV. ABRAHAM'S LEGACY (11-12)

A. A BELIEVING WIFE (11)

- 1. Initially she is faltering in her faith See Gen. 18:10-14
- 2. But then believing that she could conceive because she was convinced

B. A BIG FAMILY (12)

- 1. From one man ... multitudes
- 2. A man who believed the impossible gained the improbable!
- 3. Seeing God's promise performed See Rom. 4:17-21

V. ABRAHAM'S LESSONS

A. NOT A MAN OF PERFECT FAITH

- 1. He waivered about God's protection > Lying twice about Sarah, calling her his sister
- 2. He waffled regarding God's particulars > Having Ishmael by Hagar

B. BUT A MAN OF POWERFUL FAITH

- 1. He didn't have directions, but he believed in the director (8)
- 2. He didn't have land, but he had a Lord (9)
- 3. He had no house, but he did have heaven (10)
- 4. He had a faulty wife who became a faith-filled wife (11)
- 5. He had nothing, but God gave him everything (12)

CONCLUSION:

If we follow God's plans and believe God's promises we will gain God's provisions
