KNOWING GOD L John 2:12-14

Today let's consider some aspects of what truly knowing God involves.

I. KNOWING GOD INITIALLY (12)

- Little Children
- A. THEIR DESIGNATION: "Little children"
 - These who have been born into God's family
- B. THEIR DISTINCTION: "Sins forgiven"
 - 1. The guarantee: All of their sins were forgiven
 - See Acts 10:43
 - 2. Being guilt-free
- C. THEIR DELIVERANCE: For His name's sake
 - Literally: On account of the name of Him (Jesus) alone

II. **KNOWING GOD INTIMATELY** (13a, 14a)

- Fathers
- A. THEIR ASSURANCE: They know Him
 - They know that they know God and not just about Him.
- B. THEIR ABILITY: Knowing the One who is from the beginning
 - Understanding and correlating the things of God
- C. THEIR ACTIONS: Responding to what they know
 - With intimate worship and humble confession
- See Job 42:1-6

III. KNOWING GOD DYNAMICALLY (13b, 14b)

- Young men

A. THEIR VITALITY: Strong

- Able-bodied, enthusiastic, independent and maturing

B. THEIR VIRTUE: The Word of God abides in them

- 1. They eat right: Feasting on the Word
 - See Josh. 1:8, Jer. 15:16 and II Tim. 3:16-17
- 2. They keep right: Psalm 119:11

C. THEIR VICTORY: They have overcome the evil one

- Properly armed (Eph. 6:10-12), engaged, effective and proud

IV. KNOWING GOD TRUSTINGLY (13c)

- Children

A. THEIR SIGNIFICANCE

- 1. These are immature ones
- 2. These need protection and instruction

B. THEIR SITUATION: They know God

- 1. Assurance: They know God as a Father who loves and cares for them.
- 2. Excitement: They eagerly reach out to him for loving interaction See Gal. 4:4-6
- 3. Compliance: The seek to understand and follow His directions, even though they may not understand why He says is guiding in that way.
- 4. Devotion: They study Him and seek to mimic Him

CONCLUSION:

Knowing God involves ...

- 1. Forgiveness at new birth
- 2. Assurance as fathers
- 3. Victory as young men
- 4. Trust as children
