# Acts 19:29

# We should praise Christian workers who faithfully serve others.

# I. ARISTARCHUS: AN ENDURING ASSISTANT

# A. RIOT ENDURANCE - Acts 19:21-20:4

- 1. Demetrius stirs up a disturbance against Paul (19:23-28)
- 2. A confused mob capture two of Paul's assistants (19:29)
- 3. The City Clerk intervenes (19:35-41)
- 4. Aristarchus stays committed to the next mission (20:4)

# B. DELAY ENDURANCE - Acts 21:15-24:27

- 1. Aristarchus goes with Paul to Jerusalem for the relief effort (21:15)
- 2. Paul is arrested there (21:27)
- 3. Aristarchus likely ministers to Paul at this time (24:23)
- 4. Paul is imprisoned here for two years (24:27)

# C. SHIPWRECK ENDURANCE - Acts 25:1-28:10

- 1. Paul appeals to Caesar (Acts 25:7-12)
- 2. Paul is sent to Rome via ship and Aristarchus accompanies him (27:1-2)
- 3. The voyage is marked by shipwreck and near death (27:13-20)

# D. IMPRISONMENT ENDURANCE - Col.4:10 and Philemon 23

- 1. Aristarchus is imprisoned with Paul Col. 4:10
- 2. Paul acknowledges Aristarchus as a fellow worker Philemon 23

# II. **EPAPHRAS**: A COMMITTED MINISTER - Col.1:7-8 and 4:12-13

# A. A COMMITTED PREACHER - 1:7-8

- 1. The founding pastor (7a)
- 2. A devoted man (7b)
- 3. One working on Paul's behalf (7c)
- 4. Informing Paul about his church's growth (8)

# B. A COMMITTED PRAYER - 4:12-13

- 1. Epaphras' contact with Paul in jail (12a)
- 2. He labors fervently in prayer (12b)
  - Literally: He agonizes with intense effort
- 3. He is focused on the spiritual maturity of his congregation (12c)
- 4. His intense desire was obvious to Paul (13a)
- 5. He was concerned about nearby churches as well (13b)

# III. **STEPHANAS:** A DEVOTED SERVANT - I Corin.16:15-18

#### A. THE HOUSEHOLD

- 1. These are those who are well known to the congregation
- 2. These had been baptized by Paul, probably in Athens cf. 1:16

#### B. THEIR HABITS

- 1. They devote themselves to ministry (15)
- 2. Voluntary and systematic ministry
- 3. They were others oriented

# C. THEIR HONOR

- 1. Submit to such (16)
- 2. Acknowledge such (18)
