## **John 20:11-15**

**When people see Jesus they are transformed.**

### **I. CONCERNED MARY SAW JESUS** - John 20:11-18

- A. HER DILEMMA: Jesus is taken! (1-2, 11-15)
- B. THE DIALOGUE: Jesus is talking (16-18)
- C. THE DISCOVERY: Jesus is tender  
*- When concerned Mary saw Jesus, she was comforted.*

*- When conflicted Peter saw Jesus, he was cleansed.*
