# II Chronicles 31:3-19

Hezekiah understood God's plan of providing for His servants through the giving of His people

Following a great revival Hezekiah understood the need for great reforms so that the work of God could continue.

### I. THE GIVING OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT (4-11)

## A. HEZIKIAH'S INVOLVEMENT (3-4)

- 1. Leadership (3)
- 2. Instruction (4a)
- 3. Motivation (4b)
  - Make provision for the religious workers so that they could be solely devoted to the work of God

## B. ISRAEL'S IMMEDIATE RESPONSE (5-7)

- 1. All were giving (5-6)
  - When people are properly addressed and piously inspired (by a good example v.3) they will give readily and liberally
- 2. Continuous giving (7) > Throughout the harvest season

#### C. THE NATION'S AMAZING GENEROSITY (8-11)

- 1. The Blessing (8)
- 2. The Heaps (9-10)
  - The bounty was due to blessing (10)
- 3. The Storerooms (11)

## II. THE **ADMINISTRATION** OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT (12-19)

## A. SOME COLLECTED (12-13)

- 1. Because people were faithfully bringing their contributions (12a)
- 2. Some were put in charge of receipts

## B. OTHERS DISTRIBUTED (14-19)

- Distribution policies were in place (15-19)
- a. Distribution was made through thirteen cities of priests (15)
- b. Fairness was sought in all things (15b)
- c. There was special pay for those working their course in the temple (16b, 17b)
- d. The basis for pay was determined (17)
- e. Provisions were made for the worker's families (18)
- f. Provision was made for the country workers (19)

## III. SOME PRINCIPLES REGARDING FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- A. There are times when one person may be used to inspire others to give
- B. God's plan for providing for His workers involves His people's gifts.
- C. Acceptable giving should be voluntary and consistent.
- D. Order is necessary in handling donated funds.
- E. Support for all those involved in God's work is encouraged
- F. There is a wonderful excellence in Christian liberality
