# **ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER**

# **Romans 15:14**

In order for the church to function well, we need to encourage one another.

## I. **OUR QUALIFICATIONS** - Romans 15:14

- We're able to warn each other
- A. ATTITUDE: Full of goodness
  - 1. Truly concerned: An empathy with the wanderer
  - 2. Without corruption See Matt. 7:3-5 and Rom. 14:13
- B. APTITUDE: Filled with all knowledge
  - 1. Accurately handling God's Word Col. 3:16a
  - 2. Providing scriptural support for any areas of concern
- C. ABILITY: Able to admonish (or instruct) one another
  - 1. Explanation: One who councils, instructs, corrects, exhorts or warns
    - Note I Thess. 2:11-12
  - 2. Examples:
  - a. Warning of sin Luke 22:31-32
  - b. Showing a fault Matt. 18:15
  - c. Informing about falsehood Acts 20:29-32
  - d. Restoring a transgressor Gal. 6:1-2
- D. ACCREDITATION: "I am convinced"
  - 1. Paul's Perception: He is certain that Christians and churches can do this
  - 2. God's Plan: Adequately equipping the congregation to admonish and instruct one another

#### E. APPLICATION

- 1. Reality
- a. These warnings and admonitions involve risk ... people do not always respond favorably
- b. These warnings and instructions are people-dependent and not pastor-dependent
- 2. Responses: A gracious gentleness must always be evident
- a. I've heard you yelling at the kids ... Is everything alright?
- b. You told me something different than I heard you tell them ... What's up?
- c. Is there any possibility that you are becoming bitter because of this trial?
- d. I saw your car at the liquor store ... do you have a drinking problem?

#### II. **OUR COMMANDS** - Hebrews 3:12-13

- We must watch out for each other

#### A. PAY ATTENTION TO OTHERS (12)

- 1. The Duty: See to it > Carefully note ... Be on the lookout ... Beware
- 2. The Dangers
- a. Wrong devotion: A heart of unbelief ... a faltering faith
- b. Wrong direction: Falling away from the living God

#### B. PARTNER WITH OTHERS (13)

- 1. Be present: Literally > Come alongside
- 2. Be prompt: Before the day is over
- 3. Be protective
- a. So that none are deadened by sin See II Sam. 12:1-12
- b. So that none be deceived by sin Gal. 2:11-14

#### C. PRACTICAL PARTICIPATION (Application)

- 1. I've noticed you've not been here for several weeks. Is everything OK?
- 2. Are you experiencing spiritual victories in your life?
- 3. Has that activity every tempted you to sin?

#### III. **OUR COOPERATION** - Hebrews 10:23-25

- We need to work with each other

#### A. CHOOSING (23)

- 1. A firm faith
- 2. A focus on God's faithfulness

#### B. CHEERING (24)

- 1. The Prompting: Ask how can we motivate or stir up each other?
- 2. The Particulars
- a. How can we motivate each other's love? (godly attitude)
- b. How can we motive each other's good deeds? (godly actions)

### C. CHURCHING (25a)

- 1. Be Congregated: Don't abandon the assembling
- 2. Be Counter-cultural: Some make missing church a habit

#### D. COACHING (25b)

- 1. The Pattern: Encouraging one another
- a. Coming alongside
- b. Exp: Like a coach calling the player aside for instruction
- 2. The Passion: The end of the game is near!

#### E. CHALLENGING (Application)

- 1. Notice the talents or abilities of those around you
- 2. Examples:
- a. Your write beautifully ... maybe you can send encouragement notes
- b. You're a good listener ... I think you'd be a good counselor
- c. You have a wonderful voice ... Have you ever thought about joining the choir?
- d. You seem to be pretty handy ... Maybe you should be a Trustee
- e. You work well with kids ... Have you ever considered working in Awana?
