A MAN OF INTEGRITY Job 31

Today we'll see that a person of integrity is faithful even when frustrated.

I. JOB'S FAITHFULNESS (1-34)

- Indicated by negative oaths > A catalogue of non-sins

A. NOT LUSTFUL (1-4)

- 1. His affirmation of purity (1)
- 2. His fear of displeasing God (2-4)

B. NOT DISHONEST (5-8)

- 1. Knowing that if he's been deceptive with others, God won't be deceived (5-6)
- 2. If he's been disobedient, covetous or corrupt he knows he deserves devastation (7-8)

C. NOT AN ADULTERER (9-13)

- 1. He's not been foolish nor flirty (9) [see Prov. 7:6-23]
- 2. The serious consequences of such a crime are disturbing (10-12)

D. NOT UNJUST (13-15)

- 1. Respecting his male and female slave's complaints (13) and equality (15)
- 2. He'd have not answer or excuse if questioned by God about mistreatment (14)

E. NOT SELFISH (16-23)

- 1. Consistently sharing food with the poor, widowed and orphaned (16-18)
- 2. Providing clothing to all in need (19-20)
- 3. Protecting the disadvantaged in court (21-23)

F. NOT IDOLATROUS (24-28)

- 1. He's not trusting in gold (24-25) or turning from God (26-27)
- 2. Willing to receive judgment if he denies God (28)

G. NOT VINDICTIVE (29-30)

- No joy in an enemies demise or curses to bring him down

H. NOT INSENSITIVE (31-32)

- Hospitable to all who need board and bed

I. NOT HYPOCRITICAL (33-34)

- Hiding nothing from God nor from those around around him

II. **JOB'S FRUSTRATION** (35-40)

- Notice what he's lacking

A. A LACK OF PATIENCE (35a)

- Demanding a hearing from God

B. A LACK OF REVERENCE (35b)

- Demanding an answer from God

C. A LACK OF RESPECT (36-37)

- 1. Job is cocky and self-assured about his innocence (36)
- 2. A defiant accountability (37)

D. A LACK OF RESTRAINT (38-40)

- Indignantly announcing another of his good qualities No exploitation

III. SOME THOUGHTS ABOUT INTEGRITY

A. A PERSON OF INTEGRITY IS GOD-FEARING

- 1. Living in light of God's looking (4)
- 2. Aware of an accountability to God (14)
- 3. Terrified of God's majesty (23)
- 4. Concerned about offending a holy God (28)

B. A PERSON OF INTEGRITY IS OTHERS-ORIENTED

- 1. Demonstrating a godly attitude and good actions toward those around him or herself
- 2. With the exception of idolatry (24-28) and hypocrisy (33-34), all the characteristics he notes affect his relationships with his community

C. A PERSON OF INTEGRITY IS SELF-DISCIPLINED

- 1. Reality: Job's conduct was blameless but now his conditions are brutal
- 2. Response: Job is faithful though frustrated
- a. He is not alone in this ... others have been there.
- b. Consider Joseph, Moses, Jeremiah, Paul and John

CONCLUSION:

Job was faithful though frustrated

- So now what?
- Quit talking! (40b)
