1. What do you feel is the hardest part of sowing seed?

 - a. How does this line up with the idea of sowing “out there?”
 - b. Why do you think churches do this?

3. What are some examples of carrying seed that you’ve employed or seen others use?

4. What are your experiences with sharing the gospel?
 - a. Weeping situations?
 - b. Joyous celebrations?

5. Review I Corinthians 9:19-23. Paul’s methods were used to “win more” (19) and “for the sake of the gospel.” (23).
 - a. Do you feel that some could have accused Paul of being insincere?
- How would you answer that charge?
 - b. Could his approach be seen by others as that of having no convictions?
 - c. Since we don’t have slaves (19), Jews (20), lawless Gentiles (21) or weak ones (22) among us, how do we apply this text?

6. Galatians 6:9 warns of two dangers.
 - a. What are they?
 - b. How do we overcome them?

7. What new insights or encouragement did you receive from his message?
