¹ John places this event before the Triumphal Entry for chronological reasons, but the others have it for context to give reason for Judas' presence at Caiaphas' palace. John has it in the right place.

² This was Jesus' first time clearing the Temple. Some think they may be the same, but the timelines do not match up. Obviously, the Jewish leaders did not learn from this event.

³ This would have most likely taken place around midnight when most would be sleeping so they would not cause a riot.

⁴ The trials would have been in the early hours of the morning to not raise suspicion. This would of also been during Passover time and temple trials would have been illegal.

⁵ The Roman trials would have come after the Jewish Trials: 1) Jews need to bring a charge in order to have them tried and 2) Romans would not have cared enough to get up any earlier than 6am for a Jewish trial.

⁶ This would have taken place between 9am and 3pm
