 COVERINGS OF FIND LINEN AND PURPLE (V. 22).
- 2. GOURMET CHEF: "SHE IS LIKE MERCHANT SHIPS; SHE BRINGS HER FOOD FROM AFAR." (V. 14)
- 3. Real Estate Developer: "She considers a field and buys it;" (v. 16a)
- 4. GARDENER: "FROM HER EARNINGS SHE PLANTS A VINEYARD." V. 16B)
- 5. Fitness Devotee: "She girds herself with strength and makes her arms strong." (v. 17)
- 6. FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEER: "SHE EXTENDS HER HAND TO THE POOR, AND SHE STRETCHES OUT HER HANDS TO THE NEEDY." (V. 20)
- 7. MERCHANT: "SHE MAKES LINEN GARMENTS AND SELLS THEM AND SUPPLIES BELTS TO THE TRADES-MEN." (V. 24)
- 8. TEACHER: "SHE OPENS HER MOUTH IN WISDOM, AND THE TEACHING OF KINDNESS IS ON HER TONGUE." (V. 26)

VERSE 27 SUMMARIZES HER DEVOTION TO HER FAMILY. "SHE LOOKS WELL TO THE WAYS OF HER HOUSE-HOLD, AND DOES NOT EAT THE BREAD OF IDLENESS."
