THERE ARE MANY APPLICATIONS I COULD MAKE ABOUT THIS, BUT I WON'T.

THE CHURCH CAN PROVIDE ALL THE BIBLE STUDIES, SMALL GROUPS, FELLOWSHIPS, OUTREACHES, MISSION TRIPS, PROGRAMS, AND ACTIVITIES NEEDED TO HELP PEOPLE GROW BUT UNLESS THEY DECIDE THEY WANT TO ON THEIR OWN, IT WILL BE HARD TO GROW STRONG AND RESILIENT TO THE DANGERS OF THIS WORLD.
