

**NOTEABLE NOAH:**  
**FATHER AMID THE FLOOD**  
**Genesis 6**

**We need men of holiness in the midst  
of a world of wickedness!**

- Noah is notable as a holy man amid a horrible world.
- Let's look at some of the qualities of this godly dad and seek to duplicate them.

**I. NOAH WAS A RIGHTEOUS MAN** - Genesis 6:9

- A. HIS STANDING: "A righteous man"
  - No charges, clean, upright, unashamed and guiltless
- B. HIS CHARACTER: "Blameless in his time"
  - A man of integrity and consistency
- C. HIS PARTNER: "Noah walked with God."
  - Consider his choice, habit and relationship

**II. NOAH WAS A RELIABLE WORKER** - Genesis 6:13-22

- A. READY TO HEAR FROM GOD (13-21)
  - 1. He knew man's peril (13, 17)
  - 2. He heard God's promise (18)
  - 3. He understood God's plan
- B. READY TO HEED GOD'S INSTRUCTION (22)
  - 1. He was Obedient: "Thus Noah did."
  - 2. He was Observant: "According to all that God had commanded him."
    - This involved perspiration, perseverance and precision

### **III. NOAH WAS A RESPONSIBLE FATHER**

#### **A. NOAH'S FAITH - Hebrews 11:7**

“By faith Noah, being warned *by God* about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household ....”

#### **B. GOD'S FAVOR - Genesis 7, 9**

1. Approval - Gen. 7:1
2. Deliverance - Gen. 7:23
3. Blessing - Gen. 9:1
4. Promise - Gen. 9:8-17

### **CONCLUSION:**

#### **Noah was a good man:**

1. A righteous man amid a rotten mankind
2. A reliable worker amid the remarkably wicked
3. A responsible father among repulsive fathers

#### **Noah's goodness is based on his godliness**

- He is notable and noteworthy because he had a vibrant relationship with God
