WORSHIPPING GOD II Samuel 6

As David sought to reestablish godly worship in Israel, he was faced with some serious worship issues.

We can learn from David's experiences some practical lessons about elements of worship.

I. A PHYSICAL ELEMENT OF WORSHIP (1-13)

- A proper regard for sacred property

A. MISGUIDED WORSHIP (1-10)

- 1. Good Elements (2, 5)
 - Good intentions and a good atmosphere
- 2. Bad Decisions (3-10)
- a. Wrong Conveyance (3a)
 - See Exodus 25:12-15
- b. Wrong Conveyors (3b)
 - See Numbers 4:15
- c. Wrong Contact (6-7)
 - Uzzah's irreverent touch and God's immediate judgment
- d. Wrong Conduct (8-10)
 - David's anger, selfishness and stubbornness

B. GOD-HONORING WORSHIP (10-13)

- 1. Confident (11)
- 2. Correct (12-13a)
- 3. Committed (13b)

II. A PERSONAL ELEMENT OF WORSHIP (14-23)

- A proper response to God

A. DAVID'S ACTIONS (14-19)

- 1. Directed to God (14, 17)
- 2. Directed to God's people (18, 19)

B. MICHAL'S OPPOSITION (16, 20)

- 1. She despised David's dancing (16)
- 2. She declared her displeasure to him (20)

C. DAVID'S DEFENSE (21-22)

- 1. My actions were sincere (21)
- 2. My reputation is unaffected (22)

D. MICHAL'S REPROACH (23)

- 1. She bore no child
- 2. No heir from the line of Saul in the household of David.

III. SOME PRACTICAL PRINCIPLES

A. GOOD INTENTIONS DO NOT INVALIDATE GOD'S INSTRUCTIONS

- David, the people and Uzzah all had good intentions

B. GOD'S GRACE MUST NOT BE ASSUMED OR ABUSED

- Note that God graciously did nothing when the ark was placed on a cart and led by Abinadab's grandsons. But when Uzzah touched the ark, God did not act in grace but a righteous wrath.

C. WORSHIP IS A VERB!

- Do our worship responses indicate energy or enthusiasm?

D. AN UNSPIRITUAL SPOUSE CAN DESPIRITUALIZE A HOME

- Avoid the unequal yoke (II Cor. 6:14)

CONCLUSION:

God is concerned about how we handle His property and respond to Him personally.

- Does our worship glorify Him?
