HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Ephesians 6:1-4

Homes improve when children and fathers apply biblical principles.
- Let's take a look at some of those principles today.

I. **COMMANDS FOR KIDS** (1-3)

A. OBEY YOUR PARENTS (1)

- A conduct command
- 1. The Duty: Obey
- a. Listening
 - The concept involves listening because you are under your parents authority
- b. Attentiveness
 - See Proverbs 1:8 and 4:1-4 for some parental calls to "hear."
- c. Compliance
 - The idea is to hear and act in compliance with what is heard
 - Exp: Used of Rhoda in Acts 12:13 answering a knock at the door.
- d. Consistency
 - Whether the parents are there or not!
- 2. The Worship: "In the Lord"
 - Their obedience is a reflection of their obedience to the Lord
- 3. The Reason: "This is right"
 - This precisely meets God's standard
- 4. An Example: Jesus in Luke 2:51

B. HONOR YOUR PARENTS (2-3)

- An attitude command
- 1. The Requirement
- a. The fifth of the ten commandments cf. Ex. 20:12
- b. Hold them in the highest regard putting them in place of honor
- c. You place both parents in a place of honor
- d. This encompasses all of your their life and yours
- 2. The Motivation
- a. This is the first command with a promise
- b. This is the first of the commands for man's relationship with men Ex. 20:12
- c. This is a priority command with great importance
- 3. The Result
- a. Quality of life experience: It will be well with you
- b. Quantity of years: You may live long on the earth
- 4. An Example: Jesus in John 19:25-27

II. **DIRECTIVES FOR DADS** (4)

A. AVOID ENRAGING YOUR CHILDREN

- 1. Be Temperate: Do not provoke
 - Do not continually stir up or arouse your children
- 2. Be Careful: Children can become angry
 - They can lose heart or become defeated if you are inconsistent or intolerant
- 3. Be Tender
 - Be a trainer ... show them how
- 4. Be Responsible
 - You can provoke them by not providing limits

B. COMMIT TO INSTRUCTING YOUR CHILDREN

- 1. The Subject: Bring them up
- a. Nourish: Help them along by providing tender care
- b. Encourage: Bringing them up not driving them up!
- c. Model: You can not bring them where you haven't been!
- 2. The Means: Discipline and Instruction
- a. Your ways: Disciplineb Your words: Instruction

CONCLUSION:

Let's not be guilty of ignoring God's design for home improvements.

- 1. Children obey and honor your parents.
- 2. Dads avoid enraging and commit to teaching your children.
