### **I. THE PARADE (7-8)**

- A. THE KING ON A COLT
- B. THE CLOTHES ON THE ROAD

- A. REMOVE US FROM BONDAGE
- B. REPRESENT GOD IN OUR MIDST
- C. REIGN ON DAVID'S THRONE
- D. REJOICE IN THE HEAVENLIES

### **III. THE PERCEPTION**

- A. PRAISERS CELEBRATE HAPPINESS
- B. PRAISERS INDICATE SELFISHNESS

### **IV. THE PROBLEMS**

- A. DENIAL
  - Christ did not give them what they wanted
- B. DISAPPOINTMENT
  - The people are disappointed with God's plan

**V. THE PROTEST**

- A. THEIR PARADE TURNS TO PROTEST - Mark 15:12-14  
- From “Crown Him” they move to “Kill Him!”
- B. THEIR KING BECOMES A CRIMINAL - Mark 15:15-19  
- The king they welcomed they now condemn
- C. THEIR CONDEMNED THEY CRUCIFY - Mark 15:20-37

**VI. A PROPOSAL**

- A. SEE THE SHADOWS  
- Let’s look anew at the shadow of the cross
- B. SENSE THE SUFFERING  
- Remembering once again that Christ’s cross precedes His crown
- C. SEE THE SAVIOR  
- Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2 - NIV)
