# **STAND FIRM** Ephesians 6:10-17

## Consider with me God's guidelines for standing firm.

## I. **BASIC TRAINING** (10-13)

## A. BE DEPENDENT (10-11a)

- 1. The Reality
  - Anyone who thinks he or she can stand up to the devil and his crafty ways all by themselves ... Is defeated already!
- 2. The Resources
- a. The Lord's Strength (10)
- b. Our God's Armor (11a)

#### B. BE PREPARED (11b-12)

- 1. Know Your Mission (11b)
- a. The Goal: Standing firm
- b. The Danger: Some won't
- 2. Know Your Enemy (11c-12)
- a. He is crafty (11c)
- b. He has assistants
- c. He is out there!

#### C. BE VIGILANT (13)

- 1. Take the Armor Everywhere (13a)
  - Literally: You are to have taken the full armor of God
- 2. Win the Battle Every Time (13b)
- a. Resisting in the evil day James 4:7
- b. Doing everything to stand firm I Sam. 17

## II. **BATTLEFIELD CONDUCT** (14-17)

#### A. HOLD YOUR GROUND (14a)

- 1. Stand Firm!
- 2. Remain Faithful

#### B. TRUST YOUR EQUIPMENT (14b-17)

- 1. Commitment (14a)
  - Unencumbered by distractions See II Tim. 2:4
- 2. Righteousness (14c)
  - Unconformed to this world Note Rom. 12:2
- 3. Peace (15)
  - Having received the good news of salvation, this soldier is at peace with God - Rom. 5:1
- 4. Faith (16)
  - A trust in God's blessings and daily provisions I John 5:4
- 5. Assurance (17a)
  - An overcoming enthusiasm in God's ability Is. 40:29-31
- 6. Scripture (17b)
  - A confidence in and capability with the use of God's Word in the course of battle See Matt. 4:4, 7, 10

#### **CONCLUSION:**

Some say, "It's a jungle out there!"

- Paul says, "It's a battlefield out there!"
