Internship Description

An opportunity for a student intern to gain practical experience in pastoral ministry, under the direction of the pastor of Franklin Road Baptist Church.

Internship Objectives

1. Validate personal strengths and weaknesses, and influence on ministry performance
2. Display love for God and others, and the heart of a servant leader
3. Model ministry skills in a ministry setting
4. Integrate biblical training into the practice of ministry
5. Gain practical insight and wisdom for pastoral ministry
6. Develop abilities to administer and evaluate programs and ministries
7. Communicate God's truth clearly, accurately and convincingly
8. Appraise personal ministry vision

Ministry Requirements:

- Be in agreement with the Franklin Road Baptist Church Doctrinal Statement.
- Be pursuing a Masters of Arts, Master of Ministry or Master of Divinity from a Seminary.
- Serve as a ministry leader under the guidance of the pastor, in conjunction with the seminary course requirements.
- Possess a heart for the Lord.
- Accountable to the Senior Pastor, who is also the Ministry Site Supervisor

Primary Responsibilities:

- Serves as a ministry leader among the youth, from 6th-12th grade.
- Helps to design and facilitate the development of youth programs and youth ministry for children in 6th-12th grade. Helps with the administration and coordination of all activities.
- Coordinates and participates in a youth retreat/camp ministry (depending on the time of year) with the Senior Pastor.
- Works to recruit and delegate persons capable of developing and implementing Vacation Bible School (for summer internship).

Secondary Responsibilities:

- Assists the Senior Pastor in the calling and visitation ministry of the church (all ages).
 - Provides sermon and pulpit services upon request of the Senior Pastor
 - Participates in our public worship service and in other church programs and functions.
 - Attends business meetings of the church and committee/board meetings as deemed appropriate by the Senior Pastor.
 - Maintains daily scheduled office hours.
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Provisions for Student Interns:

The student intern will stay in our Ministry Home, located on the church property. It has 3 bedrooms (2 bedrooms and 1 office that can be used as a bedroom), to accommodate students with families. The student intern would not be required to pay any utilities during the internship and would also receive a weekly stipend no less than \$200. We will consider the tax implications for the compensation (housing + stipend), and work with the student intern to find the best compensation.
